### Section 1: About the proposal

<b>Title of Proposal</b>
Procurement Strategy and Sustainable Procurement Policy 2020/2021

<b>Intended outcome of proposal</b>
The Council has a statutory requirement to update and publish both its Procurement Strategy and its Sustainable Procurement Policy on an annual basis following the key changes introduced by the Procurement Reform (Scotland) Act 2014 and the Procurement (Scotland) Regulations 2016. The Council also has a requirement to consult with key stakeholder groups for both of these documents. This gives the Council the opportunity to raise awareness, attain buy-in, inform the contents of the documents and further develop engagement with key stakeholder groups.
