Argyll and Bute Council's Adoption Service is managed by the Family Placement Team as part of the council's social work service for children and families. The

- To ensure that adopters and their families are motivated, trained, skilled and supported to meet the needs of children they adopt.
- To respond promptly to recruitment enquiries by providing clear information about training, assessment, approval and support.
- To regard birth families fairly, openly and with respect when their children require to be looked after permanently away from their birth family.
- To promote the rights of children and young people to maintain connections with significant people in their lives, including former foster carers and birth family members.
